


Figure 1 Removing Bezel 4. Remove the fastener (1) as shown in Figure 1.




Figure 2 Lift the flap (1) in pull handle opening.

5. Lift the flap (1) in pull handle opening and remove the two fasteners (2) as shown in Figure 2.




Figure 3 Removing fasteners from trim panel bottom



6. Remove the two fasteners (1) from bottom of trim panel as shown in Figure 3.




Figure 4 Removing the 8 Door Panel Retainers

- 8. Lift upward and outward on the door trim panel.




Figure 5 Disconnect the door latch cable
