**Objective:** Student Will Inspect and test fuses; determine necessary action.

- Materials**
1. EYE PROTECTION
  2. Fuse Puller or Needle-Nose Pliers
  3. D.V.O.M. and Test Light
  4. All Data, owner's manual, or equivalent with location of Fuse Boxes
  5. Vehicle (see instructor)

**Procedure:** WEAR EYE PROTECTION! First, student will locate fuse boxes; draw a diagram of all fuse locations, label fuses, and include amperage ratings. Second, student will test each fuse. Finally, student will locate and identify three specific fuses assigned by instructor and get signed off in box at bottom left of this page.
