OBJECTIVE: Student will safely raise and lower vehicle on a four post lift.

MATERIALS:

1. Procedures from Instructor
2. Four post lift
3. *EYE PROTECTION*
4. *Vehicle (see instructor)*

PROCEDURE: **WATCH VIDEO FOUR POST LIFT:** To be done by EACH student.

WEAR EYE PROTECTION! Read instructions on side post of hoist. Center vehicle on hoist. Make sure vehicle is secure. Set emergency brake, put vehicle in park, and chock wheels. Walk around vehicle on hoist to ensure that nothing is in the way of the hoist coming up. Make sure all safety bars are rotated back out of way of lift.

STOP! GET INSTRUCTOR'S APPROVAL TO PROCEED! X

THE OPERATOR (*The one pushing the button!*) IS RESPONSIBLE TO ENSURE NO ONE GOES UNDER THE VEHICLE DURING RAISING AND LOWERING, AND UNTIL SAFETY BARS ARE ENGAGED!
 Raise vehicle to a few inches above working height, place safety bars in place, and lower vehicle onto safety bars. Instructor verifies vehicle safe on hoist and safety bars engaged. At instructor's direction, release locks and put vehicle on ground.
