SAFETY 1: TWO POST LIFT OPERATION

OBJECTIVE: Student will safely raise and lower vehicle on two post lift.

MATERIALS:

1. Procedure demonstrated by Instructor
2. Lift point printout, All-Data or Mitchell-On-Demand
3. Two Post Lift
4. EYE PROTECTION!
5. Vehicle with owner's manual(see instructor)

PROCEDURE: To be done by EACH student. ***WEAR EYE PROTECTION!*** Read instructions on side post of lift. Center vehicle (by weight) on lift. Place feet, RUBBER PADS MUST BE IN PLACE, under lifting points on front and rear of vehicle. Find lifting points in owner's manual or All-Data. Raise vehicle 3" off ground and have lift points inspected.

STOP! GET INSTRUCTOR'S APPROVAL TO PROCEED! X

THE OPERATOR (*The one pushing the button!*) IS RESPONSIBLE TO INSURE NO ONE GOES UNDER THE VEHICLE DURING RAISING AND LOWERING, AND UNTIL SAFETY LOCKS ARE ENGAGED! Raise vehicle fully off ground and set locks. Instructor verifies vehicle safe on lift and locks engaged. At instructor's direction, release locks and put vehicle on ground.
