Shut off engine. If valve did not make click, remove PCV valve from vacuum hose and clean out with carburetor cleaner, and retest. Reinstall PCV valve. Start engine and check for vacuum leaks around PCV valve area. Complete <u>PCV Valve Test Results</u>.
